

The planned, new airport of Qingdao will be located in Jiaozhou, according to a radio interview with a high-rank aviation official.

In the morning of 15th Aug 2012, Wang Hong, the Party secretary of Qingdao Liuting International Airport (the current airport), also confirmed a comprehensive traffic system will be added, including light rail, train and subway to facilitate this flagship project.

However, the official microblog of Qingdao municipal government "Qingdao Release" refused to state Jiaozhou as the final destination of the new airport later on the same day and insisted potential locations are still under assessment.
